
Becca and her friend Brian both loved robots.

Sometimes, they even dreamed about robots!




They loved robots so much they decided to build their own robot shop.




On Monday, the shop was finished. Now it was time to start making robots.



On Tuesday, Becca and Brian checked their supply of shapes to see if they had everything they needed to make the robots.





On Wednesday, they picked out the shapes they wanted and put them into their special robot-making machine. Can you imagine what came out the other side?







On Thursday, they picked out some different shapes and put them into their special robot-making machine. Can you imagine what came out the other side?







On Friday, they picked out some more shapes and put them into their special robot-making machine. Can you imagine what came out the other side?
